Strawberry Shortcake

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 71" x 79"

Finished Block Size 8" x 8"

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.pennyrosefabrics.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 The Shabby Strawberry 10-inch Stacker (10-6040-20)

$1\frac{3}{4}$ yards (1.65 m) cream main (C6040 Cream)

$\frac{7}{8}$ yard (85 cm) blue houndstooth (C6045 Blue)

$1\frac{7}{8}$ yards (1.75 m) cream houndstooth (C6045 Cream)

$\frac{1}{2}$ yard (50 cm) pink houndstooth (C6045 Pink)

1 yard (95 cm) teal houndstooth (C6045 Teal)

Binding $\frac{3}{4}$ yard (70 cm)

Backing 5 yards (4.6 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

10-inch Stacker

Cut $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares in the corresponding number from the following assorted prints:

- 4—blue main, 4—cream main, 3—pink main,
- 3—blue stripe, 2—red stripe, 3—yellow stripe,
- 4—red birds, 3—teal birds, 4—yellow birds, 4—blue daisy,
- 4—red daisy, 4—teal daisy, 4—cream berries,
- 3—pink berries, 4—yellow berries

Cut 3 strawberries from red houndstooth using the template provided. Add a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance if necessary for your favorite method of applique.

Cut 3 strawberry stems from teal houndstooth using the template provided. Add a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance if necessary for your favorite method of applique.

Cream Main

Cut 8 strips $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 2.

Blue Houndstooth

Cut 2 strips $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 28 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 2 strips $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 28 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cream Houndstooth

Cut 4 strips $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 50 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 4 strips $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 50 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 1 strip $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strip into 3 squares $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Pink Houndstooth

Cut 1 strip $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strip into 14 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 1 strip $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strip into 14 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Teal Houndstooth

Cut 1 strip $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strip into 14 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 1 strip $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strip into 14 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 7 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 1.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics as each block is a different combination of fabrics.

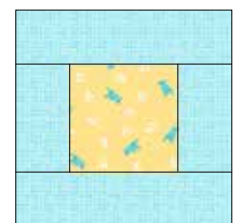
Square Block

These instructions are to make one block. Sew a houndstooth $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to each side of an assorted print $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square to create Unit A.

Sew a houndstooth $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit A to create the Square Block. Repeat to make 53 Square Blocks.

Strawberry Block

Use your favorite method of applique. Refer to quilt photo for placement of strawberry and stem on a cream houndstooth 8½" square. Make 3 Strawberry Blocks.

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the quilt photo for block placement. Lay out the blocks in 8 rows of 7 blocks. Sew the rows together to create the center of the quilt.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 64½". Top and bottom borders should be 60½".

Border 2

Side borders should be 68½". Top and bottom borders should be 72½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from The Shabby Strawberry Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.

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This should
measure 1".
