# NORFOLK FLOWERS

**FINISHED QUILT SIZE 69" x 85½"**

**Finished Block Size 12" x 12"**

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website [www.pennyrosefabrics.com](http://www.pennyrosefabrics.com) for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Houghton Hall Fat Quarter Stack (FQ-5260-24)

2 yards (1.85 m) blue main (C5260 Blue)

¾ yards (70 cm) green border (C5261 Green)

½ yard (50 cm) green check (C5265 Green)

⅝ yard (65 cm) red check (C5265 Red)

⅜ yard (35 cm) green petal (C5267 Green)

3½ yards (3.25 m) cream shade (C200-02 Cream)

Binding ¾ yard (70 cm)

Backing 5¼ yards (4.85 m)

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

### Fat Quarter Stack

Cut 1 square 4½" x 4½" and 4 squares 2½" x 2½" from blue main.

Cut 1 square 4½" x 4½" and 4 squares 2½" x 2½" from brown main.

Cut 1 square 4½" x 4½" and 4 squares 2½" x 2½" from red main.

Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" and 8 squares 2½" x 2½" from brown border.

Cut 8 squares 2½" x 2½" from green border.

Cut 8 squares 2½" x 2½" from taupe border.

Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" and 8 squares 2½" x 2½" from brown leaf.

Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" and 16 squares 2½" x 2½" from cream leaf.

Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" and 8 squares 2½" x 2½" from tan leaf.

Cut 1 square 4½" x 4½", 4 squares 3" x 3", and 12 squares 2½" x 2½" from blue spiral.

Cut 1 square 4½" x 4½" and 12 squares 2½" x 2½" from cream spiral.

Cut 1 square 4½" x 4½", 4 squares 3" x 3", and 12 squares 2½" x 2½" from green spiral. Using the template provided, cut 12 flower centers

Cut 1 square 4½" x 4½" and 12 squares 2½" x 2½" from blue circle.

Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" and 16 squares 2½" x 2½" from red circle.

Cut 1 square 4½" x 4½", 4 squares 3" x 3", and 12 squares 2½" x 2½" from tan circle.

Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" and 16 squares 2½" x 2½" from blue check.

Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" and 8 squares 2½" x 2½" from green check.

Cut 1 square 4½" x 4½" and 20 squares 2½" x 2½" from red check.

Cut 1 square 4½" x 4½" and 4 squares 2½" x 2½" from brown stripe.

Cut 1 square 4½" x 4½" and 12 squares 2½" x 2½" from cream stripe.

Cut 8 squares 2½" x 2½" from tan stripe.

Cut 1 square 4½" x 4½" and 4 squares 2½" x 2½" from green petal.

Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" and 8 squares 2½" x 2½" from tan petal.

Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" and 16 squares 2½" x 2½" from taupe petal.

### Blue Main

Cut 8 strips 7½" x WOF for Border 2.

### Green Border

Cut 7 strips 2½" x WOF for Border 1.

### Green Check

Using the template provided, cut 72 leaves. Add ¼" seam allowance if necessary for your favorite method of applique.

### Red Check

Using the template provided, cut 24 flowers. Add ¼" seam allowance if necessary for your favorite method of applique.

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## Green Petal

Using the template provided, cut 24 stems. Add  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance if necessary for your favorite method of applique.

## Cream Shade

Cut 3 strips  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 48 squares  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 6 strips  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 96 rectangles  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 4 strips 3" x WOF. Cut the strips into 48 squares 3" x 3".

Cut 2 strips 13" x WOF. Cut the strips into 6 squares 13" x 13".

Cut 2 strips  $18\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 3 squares  $18\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $18\frac{3}{4}$ " and 2 squares 10" x 10". Cut the  $18\frac{3}{4}$ " squares twice diagonally to create 12 Setting Triangles (2 will not be used). Cut the 10" squares once diagonally to create 4 Corner Triangles.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of pieces as each block is a different combination of fabrics.

## Star Block

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the cream shade 3" squares. With right sides together, place the cream shade 3" squares on top the assorted print 3" squares. Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the line to make 2 Half Square Triangles. Press. Square up the Half Square Triangles to  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make 96 Half Square Triangles.

These instructions are to make 1 block. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 8 assorted print  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. With right sides together, place an assorted print  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square on top of a cream shade  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Flying Geese A. Repeat to make 4 Flying Geese As.

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 8 different assorted print  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. With right sides together, place an assorted print  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " on top of a cream shade  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Flying Geese B. Repeat to make 4 Flying Geese Bs.

Sew a Flying Geese A to the left and right side of an assorted print  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square to create Unit C.

Sew an assorted print  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square to the sides of Flying Geese A to create Unit D. Repeat to create 2 Unit Ds.

Sew a Unit D to the top and bottom of Unit C to create the Center Unit.

Sew a Half Square triangle to each side of Flying Geese B to create Unit E. Repeat to create 4 Unit Es.



Unit E

Sew a Unit E to the sides of the Center Unit to create Unit F.



Unit F

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Sew a cream shade  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square to each side of the 2 remaining Unit Es to create to Unit Gs.



Unit G

Sew a Unit G to the top and bottom of Unit F to complete the Star Block. Repeat to create 12 Star Blocks.

## Flower Block

Use your favorite method of applique to attach the flowers, flower centers, stems, and leaves to the cream shade 13" squares. Trim squares to  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " when finished with the applique. Make 6 Flower Blocks.

## Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for Star Block, Flower Block, and Setting Triangle placement. Sew rows together on the diagonal to complete the center of the quilt. Add Corner Triangles. The Corner and Setting Triangles are intentionally cut larger in order to square up the quilt center, leaving  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance on all sides, before adding the borders.

## Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

### Border 1

Side borders should be  $68\frac{3}{8}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be  $55\frac{1}{2}$ ".

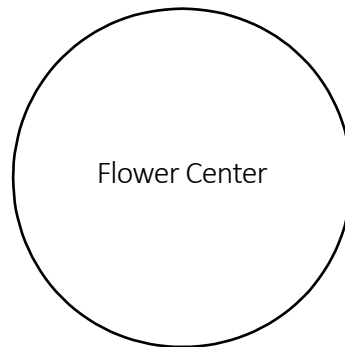
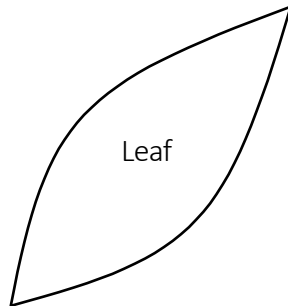
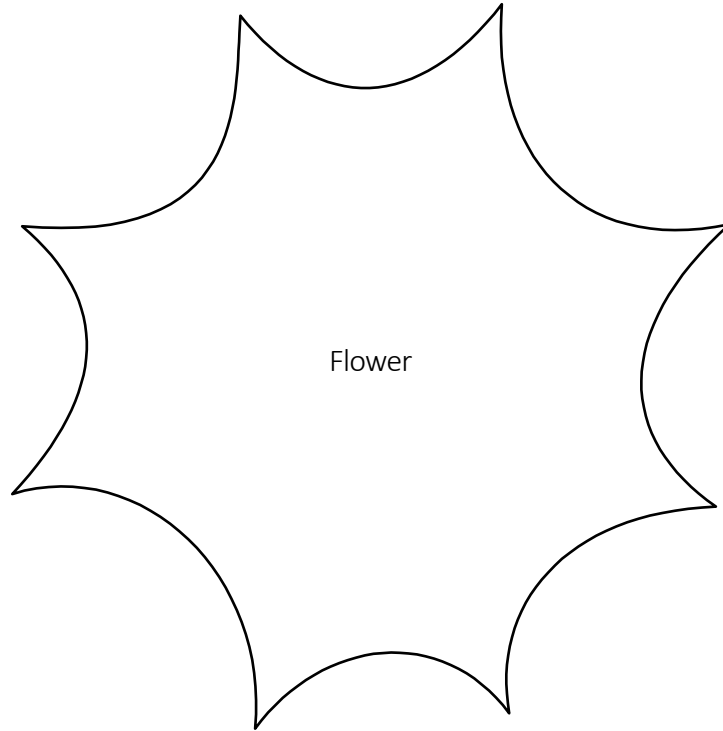
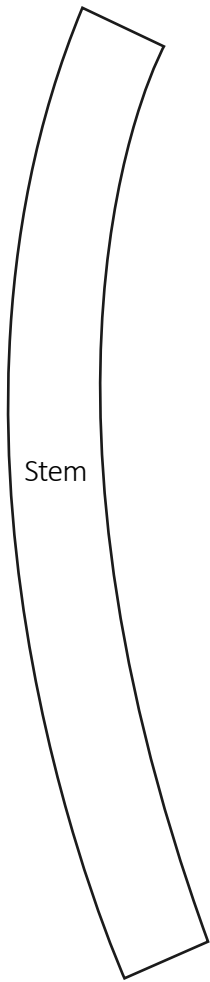
### Border 2

Side borders should be  $72\frac{3}{8}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be  $69\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the Houghton Hall Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
