FINISHED QUILT SIZE 69" x 85¾"

Finished Block Size 12" x 12"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.pennyrosefabrics.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Victoria Fat Quarter Stack (FQ-4480-18)

1¼ yards (1.15 m) black paisley (C4481 Black)

2¼ yards (2.1 m) tan berries (C4484 Tan)

¾ yard (70 cm) red dots (C4485 Red)

Binding ⅝ yard (60 cm)

Backing 5¼ yards (4.85 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Fat Quarter Stack

Cut 3 rectangles 3½" x 15" from each of the following assorted prints:

black paisley, red paisley, tan paisley, black floral, blue floral, tan floral, blue dots, red dots, tan dots, black berries, green berries, tan berries, blue fern, pink fern, red fern, tan fern

Black Paisley

Cut 7 strips 6½" x WOF for Border 2.

Tan Berries

Cut 2 strips 12½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 6 squares 12½" x 12½" for Center Blocks.

Cut 2 strips 18¾" x WOF. Cut the strips into 3 squares 18¾" x 18¾" and 2 squares 10" x 10". Cut each 18¾" x 18¾" square twice diagonally to create 12 Setting Triangles (2 will not be used). Cut each 10" x 10" square once diagonally to create 4 Corner Triangles.

Red Dots

Cut 6 strips 3½" x WOF for Border 1.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

Victoria Block

Refer to the quilt photo for fabric placement. Sew 4 assorted print 3½" x 15" rectangles together to create the following strip sets. Repeat to create 3 of each strip set.

red fern, blue floral, tan dots, black berries
black paisley, tan fern, pink fern, red paisley
tan floral, red dots, tan berries, blue fern
blue dots, green berries, black floral, tan paisley

Cut each of the strip sets into 3½" segments. Referring to the block diagram for fabric placement, sew 4 segments together to create the Victoria Block. Repeat to create 12 Victoria Blocks.



Victoria Block

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the quilt photo for Victoria Block, Center Block, and Setting Triangle placement. Sew rows together on the diagonal to complete the center of the quilt. Add Corner Triangles. The Corner and Setting Triangles are intentionally larger in order to square up the quilt center, leaving ¼" seam allowance on all sides.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 68¼". Top and bottom borders should be 57½".

Border 2

Side borders should be 74¼". Top and bottom borders should be 69½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the Victoria Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
